FIRE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY RESPONSE REPORT

July 2020

This month's activities resulted in Station 36 responding to **79** calls for service; **58** incidents were for emergency medical and **21** incidents were suppression-related. BLS care was rendered on **34** incidents while ALS care was rendered on **18** calls. The remaining medical did not require medical care. Station 36 responded to **55** calls within our section of the Village of Inverness and **0** calls in the other side of Inverness. The District logged **11** calls within the Southeast Area and **16** incidents in all other contract areas for an overall total of **106** calls.

July 12th – Tender 36 responded into Forest Lake (LZFPD) for a structure fire


