FIRE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT

February 2018

This month's activities resulted in Station 36 responding to **86** calls for service; **54** incidents were for emergency medical and **32** incidents were suppression-related. **27** medical calls were ALS transports, **11** were BLS transports, **2** were ALS non-transports, **8** were BLS non-transports, and **8** didn't require medical care. Station 36 responded to **33** calls within our section of the Village of Inverness and **4** calls in the other side of Inverness. The District logged **7** calls within the Southeast Area and **11** incidents in all other contract areas for an overall total of **104** calls.
