## **FIRE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT**

### **November 2018**

This month's activities resulted in Station 36 responding to **92** calls for service; **51** incidents were for emergency medical and **41** incidents were suppression-related. **16** of the medical calls were BLS while **32** were ALS and **3** didn't require medical care. Station 36 responded to **26** calls within our section of the Village of Inverness and **10** calls in the other side of Inverness. The District logged **15** calls within the Southeast Area and **18** incidents in all other contract areas for an overall total of **125** calls.
