## **FIRE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT**

**September 2014**

This month's activities resulted in Station 36 responding to **80** calls for service; **31** incidents were for emergency medical and **49** incidents were suppression-related. Station 36 responded to **34** calls within the Village of Inverness, with **3** responding to Barrington Countryside. The District logged **8** calls within the Southeast Area and **6** incidents in all other contract areas for an overall total of **94** calls.
